

POSTER GUIDE

- The poster must be size A0 (84.1 x 118.9 cm) and have a vertical orientation (Portrait).
- The title of the work, as accepted in the abstract, must be centered in the header. The font size should be equivalent to Times New Roman 80, so it can be easily seen from a distance of 2 meters.
- On the right side, the code with which the poster was accepted should be included to facilitate evaluation by the judging panel. The font size should be Arial 90 or an equivalent.
- On the left side, the logos of the authors' affiliations can be placed.
- Below the title, the names of the authors (Surname and initial of the first name), separated by commas, with the corresponding superscript indicating affiliation should be included. For example: Surname1, N.¹, Surname2, N.² & Surname3, N.³. The font size should be at least Arial 44 or an equivalent.
- Further down, the affiliations of all the authors should be listed according to the superscript used. The following details should be included: Faculty/Department/Research Group, Name of the University/Institution, Address, City, Country. The font size should be at least Arial 32 or an equivalent.
- Next, the body of the poster should be divided into the corresponding sections (typically: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusions, References). The section title font size should be at least Times New Roman 66 or an equivalent. The font size of the text should be at least Arial 40 or an equivalent.
- It is recommended to present the information in diagrams, tables, and graphs and to minimize the amount of text, especially in the Materials and Methods and Results sections. Titles should be placed in each table and figure.
- The reference list should follow the APA format.
- An acknowledgment section could also be included if necessary.
- At the end of the poster, the name of the event should be included (XIV Congreso Iberoamericano de Ingeniería de Alimentos).
- A reference template has been prepared. In it, the colors, fonts, section distribution, etc., can be modified, respecting the previously indicated criteria.
