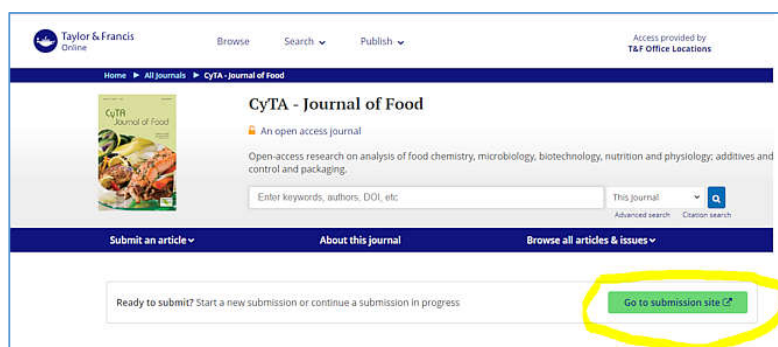

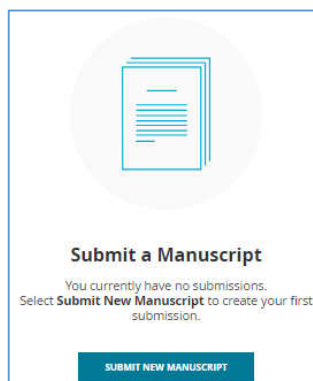
Review the authors' guide beforehand
